# **Financial Peace University to Begin October 8**

Our first FPU class last Spring met with resounding success. Twenty-five people completed the class and reported to have paid off (collectively) \$54,000 of debt in just seven weeks!

We are both excited and proud to offer a second class. We believe this is important because:

- Nearly <u>5 Million</u> people have taken an FPU course
- **81%** of couples do a monthly <u>zero-based budget</u> after taking FPU
- **89%** of FPU participants have at least a <u>\$1000 emergency fund</u> within 10 weeks

The class will be led by Mike and Gerri Munos, and Paul Gorden. It will be held on Mondays from 6:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. beginning on October 8 and concluding December 3.
